**Subject: Anaphylaxis Policy**

**Date: November 27, 2013**

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1. Information on nut allergies must be published in the Student/Parent handbook and noted on the student's medical card.
  2. A medical plan is put in place together by the parent and office including appropriate medical supplies and their storage, emergency contact information and emergency measures to be enacted. This plan is filed in the office records and provided to the student's teacher.
  3. All teachers/staff are to be trained in signs and symptoms of anaphylaxis, common allergens, avoidance strategies, use of an epi-pen and emergency plans and protocols. Training should be conducted by a health nurse before commencement of every new school year.
  4. The teacher of any classroom that has a student with life-threatening food allergies will send home a notice to parents, requesting that food item(s) be avoided for snacks/lunches. A spray bottle of cleaner will be made available should contamination occur and desks need to be cleaned.
  5. A medical alert chart, with student pictures, will be posted in "teacher only" area of Cascade Christian School.
  6. An extra epi-pen provided by the parent will be stored in the office.
  7. Any medical or health related incidents are reported in writing and kept on file in the school office.
